Did You Know

The clerk can accept your filing even if you select the wrong fees?

By editing your user profile and selecting the option that allows clerks to modify your filings, you can avoid needless rejections. Clerks will then be able to edit incorrect fees.

You may attach only one primary document per eFiling submission?

Attaching multiple documents that all require a file stamp to the same filing will result in a rejection. Remember, the lead document receives a file stamp.

Filer FAQs

Question

When I eFile a document, do I need to sign it?

Answer

A physical signature is not required from the attorney on the official document for any document that is not required to be verified or does not require signature from opposing parties.

Per Local Rule 4.2 (a) the unique identifier an attorney uses to electronically file

any document that is not required to be verified or does not require signature from opposing parties.

Per [Local Rule 4.2 \(a\)](#), the unique identifier an attorney uses to electronically file documents “constitutes a ‘digital signature’ on the particular document.”

Some attorneys prefer to type in “/s/ John Doe” in the Word document to be filed. The conversion to PDF retains the same presentation and formatting as the original document. If you have scanned in signed affidavits, the PDF conversion will retain the presentation.

Filer Tips

Orders are not file stamped until they receive a judge’s signature

- When submitting an unsigned, proposed order, make sure it is filed as an attachment and that it is preceded by a cover letter or a motion as the lead document.
