Did You Know?

Filing small claims and evictions has never been easier!

eFiling is now available for Justice of the Peace Courts in selected jurisdictions including Bell, Randall and Williamson Counties, with more jurisdictions on the way.

Only the lead document in a filing receives the file stamp.

If you have multiple documents that require file stamps, submit them as separate eFilings. Submitting more than one document that requires a file stamp in a single filing may result in filing rejection by the clerk.

Filer FAQs

Question

Can I eFile discovery materials?

Answer

Rule 191.4 provides that selected discovery materials must not be filed with the court. TexasOnline electronic service allows you to exchange these materials with case parties without filing them with the court.

Question

If the eFiling system is down or the clerk rejects my eFiled document, will I miss my filing deadline?

Answer

Please consult with the clerk in each instance. eFiling does not extend filing deadlines; however, Rule 7.2 provides that undue prejudice shall be avoided for persons using electronic filing in good faith.

Question

Are eFiling fees considered as court costs?

Answer

The Supreme Court's standard rules for electronic filing provide that a fee collected by the Clerk in connection with electronic filing that is in addition to regular filing fees, will be considered as a court cost.

Filer Tips

Scanned paper documents can exceed the file size limits

- Setting your scanner to 200 dpi will keep the file size manageable.

Some eFiling jurisdictions do not accept American Express cards

- Please contact the Clerk or your Service Provider if you have any questions about AMEX acceptance in particular jurisdictions.
